This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of January
in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and two

Between Samuel Ellis and Hannah his wife of Surry of the
one part and Worington Ellis of Southampton County of the
other part witnesseth that the said Samuel Ellis and
Hannah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
two hundred and ten pounds five shillings of good and
lawfull money of this commonwealth to him the said —
Samuel Ellis and Hannah his wife in hand paid by the
said Worington Ellis to be before the sealing hereof
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged hath granted bargained sold aliened and con-
firmed and by these presents with grant bargain sell
alien and confirmed unto the said Worington Ellis His
heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the county of Southampton the line whereof
runs ad following to w^t. Beginning at a pine a corner tree of
Howell Scarboroughs line thence N. W. course 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ pole
to a maple thence N^o 64 E $7\frac{1}{2}$ to a dog wood thence
N^o 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ pole to a pine in a branch thence N^o 81 E $6\frac{1}{2}$
pole up the said Branch thence S^o 75. E $5\frac{1}{2}$ pole to a
pine at the road thence N^o 40 pole along the said road
thence N^o 36 E $5\frac{1}{2}$ pole to a spanish oak thence S^o 53 $\frac{1}{2}$
E 10 pole to a scrub oak thence S^o 64 E $3\frac{1}{2}$ pole S^o 60 E $4\frac{1}{2}$
pole S^o 80 E $2\frac{1}{2}$ pole to a pine in a meadow thence S^o 15 E $14\frac{1}{2}$
pole to a black gum in a branch thence N^o 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ W^o 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ pole
to a pine thence N^o 67. W^o 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ pole to a pine stump thence N^o 85
S^o 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ pole to a red oak thence N^o 5. W^o 2 pole to the road
thence along the said road to the beginning containing by
one hundred and seventy four and a quarter acres to be the
same more or less which said tract of land with thence
every of their rights members and appertaining whatsoever
to the same land belonging or in any wise appertaining
and the reversion and reversioner remainder & remainder
rents dues and profits thereof and of every part thereof
