Southampton being indebted to Joshua Claude of said county for
the purchase of certain tract land &c near Jones Church by bonds
bearing date August 1801 to amount two thousand seven hundred
and eighty five dollars one half payable 25 day of January one thousand
eight hundred & two and a other half 25 day of December next
thousand & two and being desirous to secure said Claude have
well for the consideration of the said sum of two thousand
Pounds as also the sum of five Shillings in hand paid by
James Millar as Trustee for said Claude the receipt is hereby
acknowledged and the said Ben^{to} Bittle have granted, con-
veyed and sold and by these presents do grant, convey and
sell unto the said Claude one Negro boy named Moses for first
payment and also the said Tracts land purchased of said
Claude for second Payment to have and to hold unto
said Joshua Claude to the use of proper use and behoof of him
the said Joshua Claude his heirs Executors & administrators
forever in Special trust and confidence & to them in and
