This Indenture made this fifth day of January in the year eighteen hundred & two between Nathan Worrell & Melinda his wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Worrell of said county and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Nathan Worrell delivered his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty five pounds eight shillings and nine pence half penny to them in hand paid before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Nathan Worrell and Melinda his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully satisfied hath bargained sold delivered and doth by these presents bargain sell and deliver unto the said Joseph Worrell a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the county aforesaid containing by estimation eighty five or half acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a pine a corner in the said Nathan Worrells line standing at the side of the New tree Branch thence up the said branch to a line of pine marked as a dividing line between the said Nathan & Joseph Worrells thence along that line to a pine a corner in William Revels line thence along the said Revels line to a pine a corner in William Richs line
