This Indenture made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and two; Between James Butts and Sally  
 his wife of the county of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part  
 Francis Clements of the same County, and State aforesaid of the other  
 part. Whereas that the said James Butts & Sally his wife for and in  
 consideration of the sum of Two thousand two hundred dollars -  
 current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid, at and before the  
 signing Sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged, and the said James Butts and Sally his  
 wife therewith satisfied, contented & paid hath bargained sold  
 aliened Enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth hereby absolutely  
 bargain sell alien enfeoff & forever confirm unto the  
 said Francis Clements his Heirs & assigns, two certain tracts  
 of land lying and being situated in the parish of Motte  
 way & County of Southampton on the North side of adjoining Malloway  
 River R. the one tract is the land wherein the said James Butts  
 now lives and bounded as is expressed in a deed from Thomas Butts  
 to Butts, and duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton  
 which said land was conveyed to the above James Butts by  
 his father Peter Butts, by deed of gift, duly recorded in the court before  
 said relation thereto had, will make the same more fully appear  
 containing as therein expressed four hundred & fifty acres be  
 the one more or less. - The other tract, is the land which the above  
 named James Butts purchased of Joseph Nick and Phenebe his  
 wife, and duly recorded in the County Court aforesaid in July 1793  
 the boundaries of which will appear by a reference to the said deed  
 containing as therein expressed one hundred acres more or less  
 making in both tracts five hundred & fifty acres together -  
 with all houses gardens, orchards, woods, meadows, water  
 Water Courses, mines, minerals, and all other the profits  
 and commodities thereto belonging or in anywise after  
 coming to have and to hold the said lands and premises for  
 misesland every of the appurtenances, unto the said  
 Francis Clements his Heirs & assigns forever, to the only proper  
 use and behoof of the said Francis Clements His Heirs &c. and  
 the said James Butts & Sally his wife for themselves their heirs  
 Executors and administrators doth covenant & agree to and
