said Sally and examine her privately and apart from her husband  
whether she hath executed the same duly freely and  
voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her husband  
and so whether she is willing the said Injunction should be re-  
corded in the court of our said county and when you have  
examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement  
of the same that you openly and distinctly certify  
us thereof under your handz and seals returning to us  
also this writ with the said Injunction annexed with  
Samuel Kelloe clerk of our said court at his office the 29<sup>th</sup>  
day of April 1802 and in the 26<sup>th</sup> year of the commonwealth  
of Southampton County to wit Sam. Kelloe

By virtue of the within commission to us annexed, we have  
personally gone to the within named Sally Butts wife of  
James Butts and examined her privately and apart from her  
said Husband touching the deed of conveyance hitherto annexed  
which she the said Sally did before us acknowledge to be her act  
and the same was by her done freely and voluntarily without  
the persuasion or threat of her said husband, and also that she is  
willing the same should be recorded in the said court of  
Southampton, certifying under our hands and seals this 29<sup>th</sup> day  
of April 1802.
