This Indenture made this 19th day of January one thousand
 eight hundred and two between Jordan Jones of Southampton
 county of the one part and William Briggs of the same county
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Briggs for
 in consideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy five
 pounds lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid
 by the said William Briggs the receipt whereof he doth
 hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold
 and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto
 the said Jordan Jones his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county
 of Southampton and bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak
 now a dead in the mill pond a corner on said William Briggs's
 line thence Northerly along a line between said land and the land
 the said Jones purchased of William Wren to a corner to white Oak
 on Richard Wrens line, thence Westwardly along the said Wrens
 line so the swamp commonly called the old mill swamp thence
 down the said swamp to the deep branch thence up the deep
 branch and mill pond to the white oak begun at together
 with the half of the mill the said William Briggs bought of
 the said Jordan Jones together with all and singular the ap-
 purtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining
 it being the tract or parcel of land the said William Briggs
 purchased of the said Jordan Jones and was duly recorded
 yesterday in the county court of Southampton and by these presents
 acknowledged to the said Jones his heirs and assigns forever to have
 and to hold the said tract and parcel of land together with
 all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in
