 Charlotte his wife do hereby acknowledge. They the said
 Haray Applewhite and Charlotte his wife, have ~~been~~
 granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do
 grant, bargain, sell alien and confirm unto the said
 Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever, all that
 tract or parcels of land whereon the said Haray Applewhite
 lately lived in the County of Southampton and is bounded as
 follows to wit beginning at the said Thomas Applewhite
 Mill pond at a line formerly John Applewhite now
 Thomas Applewhite and Thomas Peto thence along
 the said line to the Recay Branch thence up the said
 Branch to John Peto thence along the said Peto
 line to Peterson Sveys line thence along the said Sveys
 line to the said mill pond on the Ploughman Swamp thence
 across the said mill pond to the beginning containing by old
 Survey two hundred and fifty eight acres and a half, be
 the same more or less and also all lands, woods, trees, with
 Waters, commons, profits commodities Hereditaments and appur-
 tenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land and
 premises or any part thereof belonging or in any wise
 appertaining to the same and also the reversions and remainders
 remainder and remainders next and issues of the said
 Premises and of every part or parcel thereof and all the
 Estate right title interest claim and demand whatever
 of them the said Haray Applewhite and Charlotte his
