

This Indenture made this nineteenth day of July in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two

Appletonite and wife between Harry Applewhite of the county of Southampton of the  
one part and Thomas Applewhite of the same County of the other  
Appletonite Part, witnesseth, that the said Harry Applewhite and —  
Esq: received & Thomas Applewhite Aug 25<sup>th</sup> 1818 Charlotte his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two  
hundred and fifty nine pounds to them in hand paid  
the receipt whereof they the said Harry Applewhite and  
Charlotte his wife do hereby acknowledge. They the said  
Harry Applewhite and Charlotte his wife have ~~hereby~~  
granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do  
grant, bargain sell alienated and confirmed unto the said  
Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever, all that  
tract or parcel of land wherein the said Harry Applewhite  
lately lived in the County of Southampton and is bounded as  
follows to wit beginning at the said Thomas Applewhite  
Mill pond at a line formerly John Applewhite now  
Thomas Applewhite's and Thomas Peets thence along  
the said line to the Racy Branch thence up the said  
Branch to John Peets line thence along the said Peets  
line to Peterson Ivory line thence along the said Ivory  
line to the said mill pond on the ploughed swamp thence  
down the said Mill pond to the beginning containing by survey  
two hundred and fifty eight acres and a half, to  
the same more or less are all lands, woods, trees, wod-  
waters, commons, profits commodities hereditaments and appur-  
tenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land and  
premises or any part thereof belonging or in anywise  
pertaining to the same and also the reversion and remainder  
remainder and remainders rents and services of the said  
Premises and of every part or parcel thereof and all the  
Estate right till interest claim and demand whatsoever  
of them the said Harry Applewhite and Charlotte his  
wife for and to the said tract of Land and premises  
and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the  
said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns both only
