The Commonwealth of Virginia to William Bailey and James Gee, gentlemen greeting whereas Samuel Johnston and Rebecca Johnson his wife have by their Inventory of Bargain and Sale made the 19th day of February 1802 conveyed unto Abraham Barr of the County of Southampton the sume estate of land in one hundred acres of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and whereas the said Rebecca cannot conveniently travel to the court of law said County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Rebecca shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Inventory which is hereto annexed and we command you to go personally to the said Rebecca and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she is willing the same as is should be recorded in the court of the County aforesaid and whether she hath executed the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her husband and when you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement of the same that you distinctly and openly certify us thereof under your hands and seals returning to us also this writing with the said Inventory annexed witness Samuel Kello clerk of our said court at his office the 15th day of March 1802 and in the 29th year of our foundation
