This Indenture made this 12th day of February in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and a two; Between
Willis Washington of the county of Lancaster Parish of Mottoway and State
of Virginia of the one part and James Scott of the county Parish and
State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Willis
Washington for and in consideration of the just and full sum of
Four hundred and a fifty Dollars current money of Virginia
by the said James Scott to him in hand paid, the receipt where
of the said Willis Washington doth hereby acknowledge & thereof
acquits and discharge the said James Scott and his heirs and
assigns forever, and himself therewith fully and intirely satisfied
contented and paid the said Willis Washington hath granted
bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, set over, delivered and
confirmed, and by these presents with grant, bargain, sell alien, enfeoff, re-
sit over deliver and confirm unto the said James Scott and to his heirs
and assigns forever all that plantation meadow tract and par-
cel of land which Joseph Washington conveyed and confirmed unto
his son the aforesaid Willis Washington, by Inaventure date the
twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord Christ 1700 or there about
the same tract and parcel of land whereon the said Willis Washington now
lives situate lying and being in the county of Southampton and
Parish of Mottoway aforesaid containing by estimation two Hundred and
fifty acres or there about more or less bounded and described as by the
said Joseph Washingtons deed to the said Willis Washington is, in force &
declared, provided in the aforesaid County relation being thereto
that the bounds will more fully appear and all the houses out houses
edifices, buildings, woods, ways, waters and water courses, low grounds
orchards, gardens, profits commodities, hereditaments & appurtenances
whatsoever to the same belonging, or in any wise appertaining and the
reversion and reversions remain and remain as out, issues and
profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or de-
mand of him the said Willis Washington of in, and to the same,
and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said
Plantation, meadow, tract, and parcel of two hundred and fifty
acres of land and premises, with all and every the appurtenances apper-
taining unto him the said James Scott and to his heirs and assigns forever to
