gage bearing date the 20th day of September 1798 did sell and
convey unto Jordan Denson & to Jordan Denson & company
and to their heirs and assigns together with other valuable
Property, one certain tract or parcel of Land where as the s^d
Spencer Pierce then dwelt, lying in the county aforesaid contain-
ing two hundred and twenty six acres for the consideration and
securing the payment of a certain sum or sums due to the said
Jordan Denson and Jordan Denson & Co as in the said indenture
mentioned from the said Spencer Pierce with a proviso of
redemption and where as the said Spencer Pierce hath paid
and satisfied unto Jordan Denson a considerable part of
the said debt knowing that we the said Jordan Denson &
Jordan Denson & Co for the consideration aforesaid have
and by these presents do & vice release an & forever quit claim
unto the aforesaid Spencer Pierce and to his heirs and assigns
all the right title interest claim or demand of them the said

or to the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land mentioned to be con-
