

This Indenture made this 17th day of May in the year of our
 Lord 1802. Between John Bligh and Rhoda his wife of the county
 of Southampton and Parish of Mottray of the one part and John
 Wheabee of the same county and parish of the other part witnesseth
 that the said John Bligh and Rhoda his wife for and in
 consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred & forty
 three pounds current money of Virginia by the said John
 Wheabee to them in hand paid before the sealing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John
 Bligh and Rhoda his wife doth hereby acknowledge and
 thereupon acquit and discharge the said John Wheabee his heirs and
 assigns for ever and themselves therewith fully and intirely
 satisfied contented and paid the said John Bligh & Rhoda
 his wife have granted bargained sold aliened in full release
 set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell alien release set over allow and confirm unto the
 said John Wheabee and to his heirs and assigns forever all
 that plantation messuage tract and parcel of land whereon
 the said John Wheabee now lives situate lying and being in the
 county of Southampton and parish of Mottray aforesaid and
 being all the lands which the said John Bligh purchased of
 Jesse Brassey containing by a late mensuration one hundred
 and forty nine acres and bounded as follows to wit beginning
 at a red oak in Absalom Joiners line thence Jordan Denson
 line South 35 a. W. 134 pole to a pine a corner tree in the road
 Branch thence up the said branch S 85 E. 60 pole to the
 said branch S 75 E. 30 pole to a maple a corner tree in Henry
 Obens line then North 82 E. 90 pole to a pine a corner tree in
 Matthew Williams line then N. 31 E 80 pole to a gum a corner
 tree in Balay Dakes line in the great branch then up the
 said Branch N. 45 W. 160 pole to a gum a corner in Gils
 Westers line then S 75 E. 16 pole to a pine stump a corner in
 Absalom Joiners then S 20 W 72 pole to the beginning and
 all the houses out houses buildings woods ways waters and
 water courses profits commodities hereditaments and
