This indenture made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & two between Samuel Jones of the County of Pasquotank and state of North Carolina of the one part and Joseph Jones of the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Samuel Jones for and in consideration of the just and full sum of two thousand eight hundred and ninety Dollars & five cents to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Jones before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Samuel Jones doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Joseph Jones his heirs and assigns forever and himself therewith fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid the said Samuel Jones hath granted bargained sold alien enfeoffed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over and confirm unto the said Joseph Jones his heirs and assigns forever that Plantation message tract and parcel of land wherein the said Samuel Jones lately lived and wherein the said Joseph Jones now lives and being the lands that were devised to the said Joseph and Samuel by their father the late Samuel Jones deceased situate lying and being in County of Southampton aforesaid on and near Round Hill swamp containing by estimation Nine hundred and eighty seven acres be the same more or less bounded on one part by the lands which the said Samuel Jones sold to Capt. John Clayton and all other parts by the known ancient and neptated boundaries thereof all the houses out houses earfrees buildings woods ways water courses property commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversion remainder and remainders rents issues and profits and all the estate right title interest claim or demand of him the said Samuel Jones of in and to the same and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said Plantation message tract and parcel of nine hundred and eighty seven acres of land be the same more or less and premises with all and every the appurtenances unto him
