Especially for and consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and do bear unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Harris and as by these presents make over and convey in trust to my friend Henry Person to have and for the use interest and benefit of my loving wife as well as to and for my own use and benefit during our joint or separate lives one certain negro Girl named Cherry formerly the property of my said wife To have and to hold the said negro Cherry with all her increase to and for the use aforesaid by the said Henry Person in trust with her said increase to be subject to the disposition of my said wife by her last will and testament or by and on other instrument in writing to and amongst her children or to any one or more of them as she may think proper and such will or Deeds will or bequest to be valid and binding as to convey the right Title interest and claim of me or any other Person claiming under me of us and to the said Negro Cherry or her increase and it is further declared to be the true intent and meaning of this Present instrument that if my said wife shall fail to make such conveyance as aforesaid that then the children of my wife Elizabeth Harris shall all be entitled to an equal share of the said Negro Cherry and her increase so that neither the present children nor any future children my said wife may have shall have a right to dispose of me or my said wife during our joint or separate lives of the use and benefit thereof but that the same shall be held in trust by our friend Henry Person for during our joint or separate lives for the use interest and purpose aforesaid and for no other use interest or purpose to that to wit In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1862 -
