This Indenture made this 17th day of April in the year of our
 Lord Eighteen hundred & two, Between Michael Warren of the county
 of Southampton and state of Md. Carolina of the one part and with
 Bitte of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the
 other part as followeth I the said Michael Warren for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty pounds cur-
 rent money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William
 Bitte here the rating and delivery of the these presents the
 receipt whereof the said Michael Warren do hereby hath re-
 ceived and doth and doth by these presents grant bargain
 and sell unto the said William Bitte his heirs and assigns forever
 three certain tracts or parcels of land except fifteen yards square
 known by the place of the grave before bearing date as followeth One
 of 165 bearing date February 2^d 1724 taken up by Martin
 Middleton one of 73 bearing date November 3^d 1750 taken up
 by Joseph Warren one of 93 acres bearing date September 10th 1767
 all in estimation three hundred and thirty three acres more or
 less lying and being in the county of Southampton and state
 of Virginia and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a pin
 on Epitaphus Swamp at William Warpage line thence by his
