This Indenture made this 23rd day of February in the
year of Lord 1802 Between James Edwards of the county of Southampton
of the one part Lazarus Cook of the second part and Simon Corbett of the
third part all being of the county of Southampton. Witnesseth, that
whereas the said James Edwards stands justly indebted to the
said Lazarus Cook in the sum of Two hundred and twenty six pounds
fourteen shillings & four pence as per writing, obliging bearing date
the 10th of February 1802 and whereas for the further assurance and
securing the payment of the sum aforesaid it is agreed by the said
James Edwards & Lazarus Cook that a conveyance in trust shall be made
to the said Simon Corbett for the benefit of the said Lazarus Cook in
and to the writing obliging should not be punctually paid
with interest when due. Now This Indenture therefore
Witnesseth, that the said James Edwards for and in consideration
of the premises aforesaid and for the further consecration of the
sum of one Dollar to him paid the Receipt whereof is herby
Acknowledged, hath granted bargain'd and sold a certain
Release and confirmed and by these presents with for
him self his Heirs Executors and Assigns grant bargain'd & sell
alien make over and confirm unto the said Simon Corbett, & to his
Heirs Executors Admin^{rs} & Assigns one certain tract plantation
& parcel of land situate lying and being in the county of New
it being the land and plantation whereon the said Edwards
now lives containing by Estimation one hundred & eighty acres
