This Indenture made this 19<sup>th</sup> day of Octy in the year of  
our lord 1802 witnesseth that Abraham Carr and Mary his wife  
reson of the county of Southampton and parish of Notterway for and in  
consideration of the sum of twenty three dollars and fifty cents given  
to Inst. and lawful money of Virginia in hand paid by John Johnston the eight  
Johnston himself said Abraham Carr & Mary his wife doth acknowledge them  
Moneth above indefinitely satisfied & paid with grant bargain & have sold alienated  
and confirmed by these presents with bargain sell aline and confirm  
unto the said John Johnston his heirs and assigns a certain tract  
or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the  
oresaid parish and county on the North side of the  
main Blackcreek containing by estimation thirty one  
acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth —  
Beginning at the place now called the Dam Branch fa-  
mily called the Hopper Branch at the mouth of a small brook  
that discharge into said branch running thence the various  
courses of said name branch to a black gum a corner tree  
in Prolife Salmon line running thence South w<sup>E</sup> E<sup>S</sup> 110 pole  
to a white oak a corner tree thence down the said branch to the beginning  
with all houses out houses buildings gardens orchards —  
ways water courses profits incumbrances and appurtenances to the said  
land belonging or in any wise whatsoever and all the profits  
thereof estate right title property claims and demands whatsoever  
of them the said Abraham Carr and Mary his wife of inst<sup>t</sup>  
the same and every part thereof and all debts whatsoever existing  
touching or in any wise concerning the same Palace &c to be left the  
said Plantation tract or parcel of land in accordance the said  
Abraham Carr & Mary his wife continuing this Recd
