Debts thereon charged to amount of £13. 6. 10. leaving the balance on said acc^t 196. 6. 10. and provided the said Widowhood remained, the 1/3 part thereof being hers to wit £65. 5. 11. would leave only the sum of 130 17. 11. which said sum with interest thereon 7 years to the 31st Dec 1813 would be 45. 15. 10. making the whole estate with interest £176. 13. 9. whilst her the widows last demands on the said orphans in clothing etc, is upwards of 200 00. So that instead of the said widow being indebted to the said estates of the said Henry Ivey dec^d which was loaned to her for life or widowhood, and taken and sold by George Ivey Sen^r, the said estate is considerably indebted to her for maintenance of the orphans of the said Henry Ivey dec^d from the time of his death in the year 1800 till Dec 1813. She the said Charlotte widow is therefore finding that the whole personal estate of the said Henry Ivey dec^d has proved inadequate to the support of his said orphans. She consequently can make nor return no other guardianship account than such as the above, the orphans, having exhausted, in their maintenance and education all the personal estate of their deceased father Henry Ivey.
