The Comr. states specially, that the negroes belonging to his two wards were divided in Decr: 1843 and Rebecca J. Applewhite portion delivered over to her husband R. H. Beeman. The land belonging to the wards was divided in Decr: 1848, at which time the joint account closes. The Guardian paid the taxes on the land in 1849 after the division, which are allowed in the above amount. The above bal: is included in the separate act:
