And further I do acknowledge myself satisfied and paid and do forever quit claim, right, title and interest in the negroes given to sister Martha and myself by my aunt Nancy Joyner this 26 day of Nov^r 1837.

Joseph Joyner being my guardian I deliver this into his hands in presence of these witnesses.
