Brattle according to decree of \$24.93 each with interest thereon from 21<sup>st</sup> December 1853 their proportion of the sales of the slaves of the said Jno. Brattle according to decree of \$23.97 each with interest thereon from 21<sup>st</sup> December 1854. their proportion of the hire of negroes from the time of the death of the s<sup>r</sup> Jno. Brattle to the end of the year of \$9.20 each with interest from 1 January 1854. also the proportion of the rent of the rent of the said land from the time of the death of the s<sup>r</sup> Jno. Brattle to the end of the year of \$1.67 each & due 1 January 1854 which is a schedule amt<sup>s</sup> of property of every sort which has come into my hands as the Guardian up to this time.

I hereby certify that the only property of my kind which as yet has come to my hands as guardian to my seven younger children whose names are mentioned in my guardian bond is the proportion to which they were severally entitled from the sale of the remainder of the lands & slaves of my late husband A. J. Brattle after my death was ascertained, which amt<sup>s</sup> was received from Jno. C. Nicholson Esq. Com<sup>r</sup> to sell the same & is as follows. the share to which each were entitled out of the sales of the slaves was \$318.20 with interest from 6<sup>th</sup> March 1855. & the share to which each was entitled from sale of land \$19.50 with interest from 6<sup>th</sup> March 1856.
