Jones and Thos. Morris others and worth from \$500 to \$1000.

In Consideration whereof and as this Court has power to grant all proper relief: It

Pursuant to the annexed decree and to us the undersigned directed, we did in obedience thereto Go on the Lands named in said decree belonging to Benjamin Whitehead decd. and after fully examining the whole lands of said decd. we find he has two small tracts, one on which he lived and whose his Widow now resides containing 75 acres and one other adjoining the same containing 67 acres. The last named tract being nearly destitute of woodland we all thought it prudent and advantageous to the estate to take from the 75 acre tract a portion, so as to give to it some wood land which we did by drawing a line as follows commencing at a Black Gum Standing in a branch on a line between the said Whitehead and Sarah Jenkins, thence up a line of marked trees ^{following the branch} to a Sweet gum Standing in said branch; thence leaving the branch running a north course to a white Oak Standing near the field of house tract (75 acres) thence across the field in a direct line with the line from the gum to the oak to a persimmon tree Standing near the field on the north side; thence to a pine Standing on the line of said Whitehead and Robert Jones all of which land lying east of said land we propose to be added to the 67 acres tract estimated at 18 acres more or less which will be 85 acres in the aggregate. This 85 acres we are of the opinion should be sold as one tract and we think the feasible value is \$4

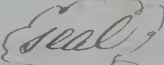

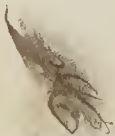

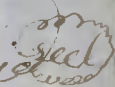
