arising from the bonds or securities hereinbefore mentioned, which may belong to the said Maggie I. Gay individually, to said J. G. Johnson, her administrator; that Wm. S. Holland, guardian as aforesaid be allowed to expend upon his said wards such part of the principal of their several estates as may be necessary to support, maintain, and educate them; that the transactions of Wm. S. Holland, guardian as aforesaid may be settled from time to time under orders of this court.

Your complainants pray that all proper orders, inquiries, and actions may be entered, taken, stated, and reported to court as the nature of this suit may from time to time require, and your complainants pray that all such other, further and general relief as to equity and good conscience may seem meet.

Notice is hereby given that reasonable fees be allowed counsel conducting this cause. And your complainants will ever pray, etc.

Your complainants say that Leland I. Gay is now about seventeen years old and attended Elon College for the first year during the session of 1903-1904, and has matriculated for the session of 1904-1905. Your complainant, Wm. S. Holland has advanced some money to him in order to get back to College after the death of his mother. He wishes to remain at college some two or three years at least. The interest on his money will not pay one half of his expences and if he is to be educated, the large part of the principal will have to be expended on him.

The other ward, James A. Gay is much younger and is now with some of his kinfolks who will charge very little board, but soon he will have to go to school and college and it will then become necessary to spend the larger part of the principal of his money.

Your complainants say that J. G. Johnson has qualified as the administrator of said Mrs. Maggie I. Gay and is made a party defendant because it is desired to have a settlement between said Maggie I. Gay and said Maggie I. Gay guardian.

Your complainants are advised that it is important and during the progress of this suit to settle the transactions of Maggie I. Gay, guardian as aforesaid; to have orders entered directing Wm. S. Holland, guardian to expend the principal or such part thereof as may be necessary on his said wards; to settle from time to time the transactions of Wm. S. Holland, guardian as aforesaid;

For as much as your complainants are without remedy save in this Honorable Court where matters are alone, and properly cognizable they pray that J. G. Johnson, administrator of Maggie I. Gay deceased, Leland I. Gay, and James A. Gay, the last two are infants under the age of twenty-one years, be made party defendants to this Bill of Complaint and be required to answer the same but an answer on oath is hereby expressly waived, that the doings and transactions of Maggie I. Gay^{now} deceased, as gusrdian for said Leland I. Gay and James A. Gay, may be finally settled and that the balance to come into the hands of Wm. S. Holland, guardian for said wards be declared by an order of this court; that the said Wm. S. Holland be required to pay any balance in his hands

with any expence if the same could be avoided. Your complainant, Wm. S. Holland says he never received any part of his compensation as aforesaid.

Your complainant, Wm. S. Holland says that he had for safe keeping in his iron safe, for said Maggie I. Gay certain bonds secured by deeds of trust as follows: A bond made by B. P. Gay for three thousand dollars and payable to Maggie I. Gay, guardian for L. I. & J. A. Gay, dated December 9th, 1899, on which there is no credit; one bond made by John W. Holland for five hundred and fifty dollars payable to Maggie I. Gay, guardian, dated March 22nd, 1902, and on which it was endorsed "Interest paid to March 22nd, 1903" and signed by Maggie I. Gay in her own handwriting; one bond by same payable to same for one hundred and fifty dollars and dated March 22nd, 1902, and endorsed as last above; one bond made by D. B. Roberts, now deceased, for nine hundred and sixty dollars and payable to Maggie I. Gay, guardian for L. I. & J. A. Gay and dated January 27th, 1900, and on which there is no credit; one bond made by Merit Sumner and Rebecca Sumner for one hundred and fifty dollars and payable to Maggie I. Gay, guardian for L. I. & J. A. Gay and on which there is a credit as of November 29th, 1902 for fifty dollars and fifty-five cents as of March 20th, 1903. These bonds are now in the possession of Wm. S. Holland, guardian as aforesaid. Your complainants know that there are credits to be placed on some of these bonds for they know of some few payments but do not know the extent or amount of credits which should be on said bonds, and they believe that a part of said bonds belong to the estate of the said Maggie I. Gay for the reason that Maggie I. Gay did not collect what she spent on her wards, but paid bills for her wards out of her own money. Her wards being her own and only children, she did not care if her money went to them, and in making an investment she had to furnish the amount desired by the borrower and if the children did not have enough money, she supplied it out of her own funds. In these ways your complainants are quite sure some of the money of said Maggie I. Gay was included in said investments.

Holland duly qualified in the Circuit Court of Isle of Wight county as guardian for Leland I. Gay and also as guardian for James A. Gay, orphans of J. S. Gay and Maggie I. Gay both deceased, giving two separate bonds each in the penalty of three thousand (3000) dollars; that prior to the time of the death of said Maggie I. Gay in September, 1904, she was the widow of J. S. Gay and the guardian of said infants and wards and that Wm. S. Holland was her surety on her bond as guardian for her two said children jointly; that said guardian settled her accounts before the Commissioner of Accounts of Isle of Wight County as will more fully appear by reference to a certified copy of said accounts filed herewith, file marked "A" and prayed to be taken and read as a part of this bill of complaint, by which it will appear that the last settlement the said Maggie I. Gay was indebted to her said ward, Leland I. Gay in the sum of \$ 2,50 $\frac{46}{100}$ and to her ward James Alton Gay the sum of \$ 2,68 $\frac{85}{100}$. Yours complainants cannot say of their own knowledge, but suppose said accounts are correct and that said balances due are also correct.

Your complainants say that Wm. S. Holland was surety for said Maggie I. Gay, guardian as aforesaid and aided her when called on by way of advice as to investments and the like, and she agreed to pay him one-half of her commissions, not wishing to tax her children and wards

last session at school, allowing him a little more money for clothing, for spending money, and for defraying the expenses attendant upon his position as a member of the graduating class, by way of encouragement, which the guardian believes was well invested.

The guardian believes that the same liberal policy should be followed now that the young man has employment. He is now about nineteen years of age, and has conducted himself in the past in such a manner as to impress his guardian with the fact that he possessed judgment a little unusual, in a boy of his age. The guardian has, at all times, endeavored to impress his said ward with the fact that the money he was spending was his, and that when it was gone the only way for him to obtain more was through his own efforts, having no one to do it for him. The said ward apparently was and is impressed with this fact. He has advised his guardian that he may desire to go to school again, and if he does conclude to do so then a considerable amount of his funds will be consumed, owing to his advanced standing in his studies, the further advanced the more expense being incurred. Until he does so conclude to do so the guardian recommends that he be allowed to pay to said ward, in his discretion, a sum not to exceed one hundred dollars per year, if he requires the same, unless he is thrown out of employment or is taken sick, which would, of course, necessitate advancement of a sufficient amount to take care of him, in which case good judgment would have to be used.

The amount he is now receiving is sufficient to cover the necessities of life, but as he has to pay a high rate of board to obtain same in a desirable boarding house but little is left him to provide the other necessities of life and allow him anything to enable him to participate in the enjoyments, even in a modest way. The said guardian, owing to the industrious disposition of the said ward, pursued a liberal policy toward him during his

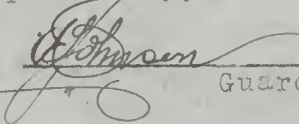
