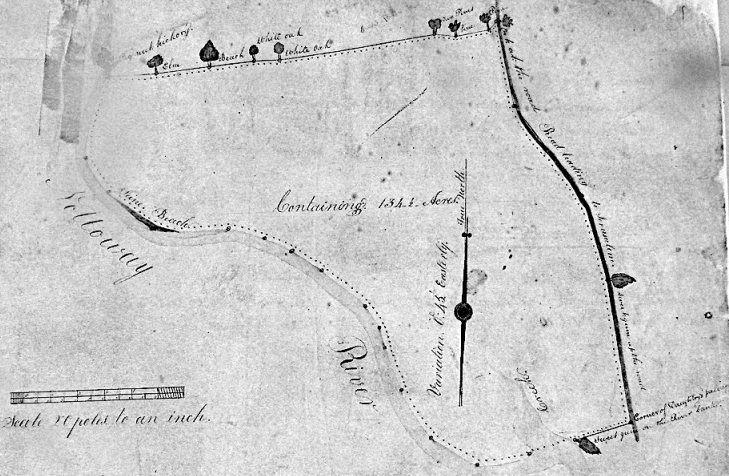

Beginning at an oak at the road, thence S. 39. 11. 5. 1. p. to a pine, thence S. 75. 11. 14. 4. p. to a pine, thence S. 11. 5. 3. p. to two large pines, thence S. 76. 30. 11. 6. 4. p. to a white oak, thence S. 77. 11. 18. 3. p. to a beech, thence S. 78. 11. 21. 2. p. to an elm, thence S. 79. 30. 11. 17. 6. p. to a pignut hickory on the river bank, thence down the various courses of the river to a sweet gum on the bank at the corner of Wm. C. Daugherty's lot, thence along the railings N. 70. E. 24. 2. p. to the road, thence N. 12. W. 58. 8. p. to a sweet gum up the road, thence up the road 119. 2. p. to the oak at the beginning.
