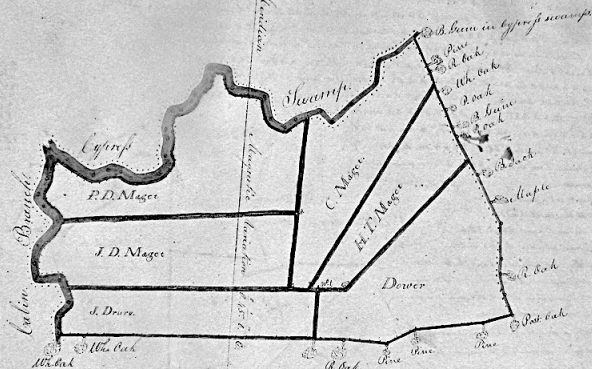




The above is a plat of the land belonging to the Estate of Samuel Magel dec'd

"Regeneries" at a post oak, a corner between M^o & Mary Angel Sts. Rayner and the above tract, thence S. 25° E. 157.6 S. 16.6 E. 16.8 p. to end oak. S. 12.4 p. S. 7.58 E. 28.4 p. S. 35.6 E. 1.4 p. to a maple. S. 31.6 E. 2.4 p. to a black S. 33.6 E. 3.4 p. to a pole. S. 27.15° E. 3.5 p. to a gum. S. 25.6 E. 18.2 p. to a oak. S. 25.6 E. 15.2 p. to a white oak. S. 23.15° E. 16.8 p. to a red oak. S. 31.6 E. 3.2 p. to a pine. S. 26.6 E. 25.6 p. to a Regum in the cy press swamp, thence down the various courses of 20 acres to the cedar branch, thence up the various courses of 20 acres to a white oak, thence S. 52.25° E. 4.2 p. to a S. 87. W. 201. p. to a red oak. W. 97. W. to a pine. S. 84.6° E. to a pine. S. 87. W. 62.2 p. to a pine. S. 72. W. 2.2 p. to the beginning."

Doclea line. *homocercaria* at a stake, thence N. 55° E. p. 4 a stake in a porch orchard, E. 55° W. 26.75 p. 4 an apple tree in orchard, E. 32.46 p. 4 a small post oak, 1st denting line, beginning at a stake N. 2° E. thence N. 86° E. 175 p. 4 the cabin branch, 2nd at a stake N. 2° E. thence S. 44° W. 156.4 p. 4 the upper swamp, 2nd at a stake N. 2° E. thence N. 53.30 E. 155 p. 4 the cabin branch, 1st at a stake N. 2° E. thence S. 26.30 W. 155 p. 4 the line
