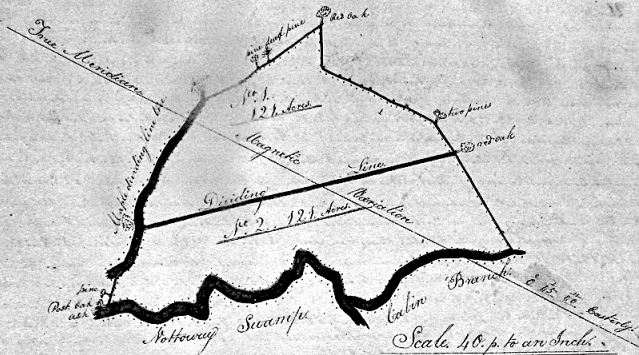




The above is the tract belonging to the estate of Lewis Williams dec'd. Bounded as follows. Beginning at an ash in Pottery swamp, thence S. 74. W. 2.5 p. to a post oak, thence S. 82. W. 5.5 p. to a pine, S. 79. W. 15.5 p. to a branch, thence up the various courses of S. branch to a pine, N. 51. W. 32.5 p. to a pine, N. 57. 30. W. 10 p. to a pine, S. 64. W. 53.5 p. to a red oak corner at Basin Rich's fence, N. 66. E. 37 p. to a pine, N. 2. W. 14 p. to a post oak, N. 6. W. 5.5 p. to a pine, N. 1. W. 16. 3 p. to a pine, N. 6. 36. W. 7.3 p. to a pine, N. 1. E. 20. 6 p. to a red oak, N. 6. W. 12 p. to a pine, N. 1. E. 26 p. to two pines chisped inward, N. 25. 36. E. 25. 2 p. to a red oak, N. 32. E. 74 p. to a red oak, N. 36. E. 19. 3 p. to the cabin branch, thence down the various courses of S. branch to Pottery swamp, thence down the various courses of S. swamp to the ash at the beginning.

Dividing Line. Beginning at a red oak, thence S. N. E. 25. 56 p. to a maple in the branch.
