TO THE HONORABLE JAMES L. McLEMORE,
Judge of the said Court:

Humbly complaining, your orator, Camp Manufacturing
Company, a corporation, which sues for the benefit of itself and all other
creditors of Willie H. Jones, deceased, who will come in and make themselves
parties to and contribute to the costs of this suit, sheweth unto the Court:

1. That it is a corporation organized and existing under the
laws of the State of Virginia, with its principal office in the County of Isle
of Wight, Virginia;

2. That Willie H. Jones, late a resident of the County of
Hansemond, Virginia, departed this life on or about the 5th day of November,
1920, seized and possessed of an undivided six-sevenths interest in and to
certain real estate lying, situate and being in said County, and more particularly
described as follows:

All that certain tract, piece or parcel of
land, lying, situate and being in Holy Neck Magisterial
District, Hansemond County, Virginia, more particularly
shown on a certain plat made by W. F. Easen, Surveyor,
September, 1918, which said plat is duly of record in
the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the
County of Hansemond, Virginia, in Map Book 2, page 29,

the said tract, according to the said plat, containing one hundred and one (101) acres, and being bounded on the North and East by tract designated Camp Manufacturing Company Tract Number Two (2), on the South by tract designated Camp Manufacturing Company Tract Number One (1), and on the East by tract designated Joe Owens' Tract, and tract designated Camp Manufacturing Company Tract Number Two (2); it being a part of the same property which was conveyed to the said Willie H. Jones by William H. Crumpler, Trustee, by his deed bearing date the 21st day of May, 1910, and duly of record in the Clerk's office aforesaid in Deed Book 70, page 6.

3. That the said Willie H. Jones was, at the time of his death, and still is indebted to your orator in the sum of \$1,436.93, with interest thereon from the 20th day of June, 1923, and \$ costs, which indebtedness is evidenced by a certain judgment obtained by your orator in this Honorable Court on the 5th day of April, 1924, against H. Carey Jones, Administrator of the estate of the said Willie H. Jones, deceased, the said H. Carey Jones, since the death of the said Willie H. Jones, having qualified as Administrator of the estate of the said Willie H. Jones, which said judgment is duly of record in the Clerk's office of this Honorable Court in Judgment Docket 5, page 32.

4. Your orator is informed and believes, and therefore charges, that the said Willie H. Jones died intestate and that he left surviving him five children, to-wit, William H. Jones, L. Mary Jones, Susan Jones Cobb, A. W. D. Jones and H. Carey Jones, and that the said children are all of the heirs of the said Willie H. Jones.

5. Your orator is informed and believes, and therefore charges, that the said H. Carey Jones, who has heretofore qualified as Administrator of the estate of the said Willie H. Jones, has disposed of all of the personal property belonging to the estate of the said decedent so there is not in the hands of the said Administrator any personal property or funds out of which the indebtedness due to your orator and the other creditors of the estate of the said Willie H. Jones can be satisfied, and that the rents, issues and profits from the said real estate will not be sufficient within five years to pay the claim of your orator and the other indebtedness of the estate of the said Willie H. Jones.

6. Your orator is advised that under the law in such cases made and provided your orator and the other creditors of the said Willie H. Jones

are entitled to have the real estate of which the said Willie H. Jones died seized and possessed, sold, and the proceeds thereof applied to the payment of the debts of the said Willie H. Jones, including the debt due to your orator, and particularly if it be true, as your orator believes, that there is no personal estate out of which the said debt can be paid.

IN CONSIDERATION WHEREOF, and inasmuch as your orator is without remedy, save in a court of equity where matters of this kind are alone and properly cognizable, your orator prays that the said William H. Jones and Idonia Jones, his wife, L. Mary Jones, Susan Jones Cobb and W. C. Cobb, her husband, A. W. D. Jones and Rebie Morris Jones, his wife, H. Carey Jones and Lillie D. Jones, his wife, and H. Carey Jones, Administrator of the estate of Willie H. Jones, deceased, be made parties defendant to this bill and required to answer the same, but not under oath, answer under oath being hereby expressly waived as to each of the said defendants; that all proper references may be had and decrees entered; that the said real estate may be sold and the proceeds applied, first, to the payment of the debt of your orator and such other creditors of the said Willie H. Jones as shall come in and make themselves parties to and contribute to the expense of this suit, and the balance, if any, be distributed among the parties entitled thereto; that a proper fee may be allowed to your orator's counsel for their services in conducting this suit, and that your orator may have all such other and general relief as the circumstances of its case may require and to equity shall seem meet.

And your orator will ever pray, etc.
