Branch the said Land I give to the said Arthur White
head & the heirs of his Body lawfully Begotten
forever Item I give & demise unto the aforesaid
Arthur a Negro man Named Pompey to him & his
heirs lawfully Begotten forever Item I also give
& demise unto my Grand ^{Son} Daughter Arthur White
head a Negro Boy Named Luck to him & his heirs
forever Item I give & demise unto my Son Lewis
Whitehead the Plantation whereon I now dwell
in his Plantation a facuant to the same that I
do. Do of W^m Powers with one hundred & Seventy five
Acres of Land belonging to the same to the said Lewis
& his heirs lawfully Begotten forever Item I give
& demise unto my Son Lewis Whitehead & his heirs
