In the Name of God Amen I William Crumpler
being of Perfect sense & Memory do make & Ordain
this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form
following Item I give unto my Son John Crumpler
the Plantation I live on & the Land belonging to the
said Plantation from the upper end to the Branch below
the Houses to the Bounds running up the said Branch
to an Ash a line Tree Standing in the said Branch
the said Land containing one hundred Acres more
or less to him & his heirs forever & also sixty five Acres
be the same more or less it being part of a Survey
of one hundred & thirty Acres of Land & is Divided by a
line of marked trees Between William Crumpler & my
Son John Crumpler I give the said sixty five Acres of
Land to my Son John Crumpler & his heirs forever
Item I give unto my Son William Crumpler the
Remaining part of the two tracts of Land & after my
Sons Death I give the Remaining parts of the two
Tracts of Land aforesaid to my Grandson William
Crumpler Son of my Son W^m Crumpler & to his heirs forever
Item I give unto my Granddaughter Daughter of my
Grandson W^m Crumpler by name Sile Crumpler one
