Item I give to my son Lot Griffin all the remaining part of my Land in Isle of Wight County and to his Heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Griffin the plantation whereon I now live and all the Land belonging it & to his Heirs forever Item it is my Will that my Executors do sell my Land on Secock Swamp to the highest Bidder & to make the purchaser a title to the same & the purchaser Money to pay for the Land I had of Edmund Fowler. Item it is my will ^{all the rest of} that my Estate after my just Debts & Legacies paid should be equally Divided Between my wife my three sons Jones Griffin Lot Griffin Samuel Griffin & my four
