possessed by Edward Drews I say I give the said Tract of Land
to him & the Heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten Item I
give & Bequeath to my Grandson Ralph Matthews Son of Ralph
Matthews a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying on the East
side the Angelica Swamp a Survey lately made by Maj^r Sam^l
Baker the Contents not known at Present I say I give the
said Land to him & his Heirs Item I give & Bequeath to my
Grandson Solomon Stephenson a certain Tract or parcel of Land
lying on James Branch bounded by Edward Drews Line & my
own Line the Contents unknown at Present I give the said
Land to him & his Heirs Item I give & Bequeath to my two Sons
Edward Matthews & W^m Matthews a New Survey of Land lately
made by me lying on James Branch & Bounded by the Indians
Line & the branch commonly called the Indian branch I say I
give the said Land to my said Sons to be Equally Divided &
