Negro Woman Named Pugg To him and his heirs forever
I give to my Son Thomas one feather Bed and furniture
half a Dozen Dishes and one Dozen Plates —

Item. I give to my Son William all the Remainder and upper Part
of my Land whereon I now live / According to the Division
Mentioned in that Part Given to my Son Thomas / To him
and his heirs forever I give to my Son William one Negro
man Named Sam one Negro Boy Named George and one
Negro Woman Named Sue to him and his heirs forever I give
to my Son William Forty Pounds Cash to Build him a House
also half a Dozen Dishes and one Dozen Pewter plates —

Item. I give to my Daughter Hannah one Negro Girl Named Lucy
and one Negro Girl Named Patt To her and her heirs forever
I give to my Daughter Hannah Fifty Pounds Curr. money
to be Raised out of my Estate —

Item. I give to my Daughter Priscilla one Negro Girl Named Kate
and one Negro Girl Named Jenney To her and her heirs
forever I give to my Daughter Priscilla Fifty Pounds
Curr. money to be Raised out of my Estate —

Item. I give to my Grandson John Person Son to John Person and
Dorcas his wife One Mulatto Boy Named Ben to him and
his heirs forever —
