Item. I Give my Son John Clark my Negro boy Jim & my
negro Girl Kate to him & his heirs forever; I Give my
Son John ten head of Sizable Cattle and Twenty head
of hoggs I also Give my Son John the sum of seven pounds
Cash to be raised out of my Estate to buy him a horse &
Saddle I also Give my Son John one Silver Spoon also
a bed and furniture —
