Sam & Negro Wench Lid to him & his heirs forever also tip
head of Sizable Cattle & Twenty head of hogs and a Feather
bed & furniture
- Item. I give my son Carter Clark my Negro Wench Hannah & my
Negro boy Jack to him and his heirs forever I give my
son Carter Tiphead of Cattle & Twenty head of hogs also a
Feather bed and furniture
- Item. I give my son James Clark a Sorrel mare commonly called
his mare and Twenty head of hogs
- I give all the Remainder of my Estate after my just debts
are paid to my son Carter Clark & his heirs forever
- and I here by revoke and Disannul all former wills by
me made ratifying and allowing this to be my last will
