God of perfect sense and memory do make and appoint this my
Last will and Testament Inprimis I Humbly Recommend
my Soul to God that gave it stedfastly Trusting to his gracious
acceptation thereof and my body I Commit to the Earth to be decent-
ly entorred at the discretion of my Executor hereafter Named
and for what worldly Estate it hath pleased God of his Goodness
to bestow upon me I Give and dispose thereof as follows
First I Give and devise to my son George Stephenson one pewter
plate Item I Give and devise to my son William Stephenson one
pewter plate Item I Give and devise to my daughter Elizabeth
Matthews and Sarah Stephenson the wife of Solomon Stephen-
son all my Clothes to be equally Divided
Item I Give and devise after my funeral Expences are paid
and discharged all the rest and residue of my Estate Real and
Personal to my son Solomon Stephenson And Lastly I Name
of this my Last will and Testament hereby Revoking and
making void all other wills and Testaments by me at any time
heretofore made In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this Thirtieth first Day of August Anno Dom 1730
