bequeath unto my Daughter ~~Martha~~ Martha and my Grandson
Joseph all cattle Equally divided them both and and my
Sheep likewise and to my Daughter Martha I give our
Leather Chare and the rest of my pewter to be Equally
Divided between my son and two Daughters and all the
Remainder of Estate both Goods and Chatel to my
