Item I give unto my son David Joyner one Negro Girl named Janey to him and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my Loving Wife all the residue of my Estate Goods and Chattels to her and her heirs forever

Lastly I do appoint my Loving Wife Drusilla Joyner and my Brother in Law John Boykin my holy and sole Executors to this my last Will & Testament Revoking disannulling and making void all other Wills heretofore made by me Wilnefs whereof I have put my Hand Seal this 10th Day of January 1750
