and Ordered to be recorded and on the Motion of the said  
Executor who made oath according to Law Certificate was  
granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving  
Security

Nath: In the Name of God Amen I Nath Ridley of the County  
Ridley's of Southampton Parish & Town being of sounde lense  
Will & memory do make this my last will & Testament in manner  
& form as followeth Howit<sup>h</sup> I give my soul to God the  
father of spirit in hope of receiving full pardon for my  
Sins Secondly I give my body to the Earth from whence it  
was taken to be buried in an Decent Manner at the  
Discretion of my executors & heirs hereafter named

Item I give to my son Nath Ridley the Plantation I now live  
on that is to say all the Land I hold on the Southide  
Ridley's Branch together with that I bought of Edmund  
Matthews I give the same to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & beg<sup>t</sup> to my son Nath Ridley my Water Grist mill  
by W<sup>r</sup> Newcomen with all the appurtenances thereunto  
belonging to him & his Heirs and my Will & desire is that  
the mill should be in - - - - - rebuilt out of the profits of  
the same kept in repair till he comes of age

Item I give & beg<sup>t</sup> to my son Nath Ridley these following Negroes  
to him & his heirs Howit<sup>h</sup> Prince Glasgow Tancer Young  
will and Deliah Scalak.

Item I give to my son Day Ridley the Plantation whereon Tho:  
Moss lives onto him and his Heirs forever I give to my  
son Day Ridley the following Negroes Howit<sup>h</sup> Mannell  
Jude & her Child Phillis & Pally & her Child Seckle to him & his Heirs
