Item I Give to my Son Arthur Washington the Use of 502 Acres of Land During his life and to the heirs of his Body Lawfully begotten forever Beginning at mouth of Benj^a Bailey's Spring Branch so up the said Branch to a pine corner tree from thence running a straight Line to the head of the Branch by the plant patch from thence down the said Branch to main Branch and down the main next called the Tann Trough Branch ^{so running} up the south prong to the Line from thence down the Line to the Pokefield Branch from thence down the said Branch to the Swamp then up the swamp to the first station I Give him one Negro Call^d Dick and Strong water Still upon provisor that he will Give Faith and Mary a year Schooling. Item I Give my Daughter Elizabeth Washington one Negro call^d Will. Item I Give to my Son John Washington all the Remainder part of the Land lying up the Branch for 200 Acres more or less and one Negro Call^d Jenny. Item I Give to my Son Tho^s Washington 495 Acres of Land lying in Gregor's Patents and one Negro Doll. Item I Give to my Daughter Faith Washington one Negro Call^d Amy. Item I Give to my Son Jesse Washington the Use of 150 Acres of Land During his life and to the heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten forever and all the Remainder part of the Land from Benj^a Bailey's Branch to Sam^l Cornwells Line and one Negro Call^d Roger. Item I Give to my Daughter Mary £30 in Cash and the Remainder part of my Estate to be Equally Divided between my wife and all my Children. As Witness here unto I sett my hand this fourth Day of March 1747/8
