- Item I give to my Daughter Heneraler Joyner Two Pewter Dishes and four plates and five Pounds Current money & to her heirs for ever—
- Item I give to my Daughter Constant Bennet Two Pewter Dishes four plates and four Pounds ten Shillings Current Money & to her heirs forever—
- Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Jones two pewter dishes four plates and four Pounds ten Shillings Current money & to her heirs forever—
- Item I give to Rob^t. Carr one Shilling Sterling—
- Item I give to my granddaughter Martha Revel twenty Shillings Current Money & to her heirs forever—
- Item I give to my Grandson Andrew Griffin Son of Epenetus Griffin my Mulatto boy named Dick and to his heirs forever he paying half the Charge of proving my Will—
