Item I Give unto my Daughter Mary Britton one feather Bed and one Rug and one blanket and four Sheets and two pillers and bedstead and cord and mat standing in the Inward Room one washing tub and Large bowl

Item I Give unto my grand son Thomas Ricks Ten pounds Cash and six flag bottom Chares and two Iron pots and hooks and fore head of young Cattle one Chest with a Lock and kee one Doz Spoons one gallon pitcher pottle mug Ten Quart bottles

Item I Give to my grandson Robert Ricks four head of y^e Cattle that I gave Rob^t Ricks that Intended for him out of his part and one good Bed and bedsted mat and cord two Iron pots one two hold Nine or ten Gallons and one pair pot hooks one Large Iron spit one small pair Tongs and four Dishes half Doz plates one Doz Spoons two basons two small punch bowls one Vinegar Cruet and ten bottles one gallon pitcher one pottle D^r one salt Seller and one small pewter cup one
