Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Simon the Plantation that he Liveth on and the other half of my Land to he and his Heirs forever and one Cow and Calf and one Dish and one Bason

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Wife Sarah two Feather Beds and furniture During her Life and then to my Son Edmond and I Give to my Wife Sarah my Riding Horse bridle & Saddle

Item Now the Rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided Betwixt my wife Sarah and my Son Edmond

I do hereby Constitute and appoint my Wife Sarah and my Son Edmond my whole and sole Executors of this my Last Will & Testament
