Elizabeth In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Newsum of Nottoway Newsums Parish in Southampton County being in Perfect Health and Memory Will praising God for the same but Calling to mind the Uncertainty of Death do make this my Last Will and Testament in Manner & form following, First I bequeath my Soul to God that gave it & my Body to the Earth to be buried in such a manner as my Exor hereafter Named shall think fit as to my worldly Estate I give and bequeath in manner and form following

Impairis I Give and bequeath to my Son Jacob Newsum a Negro Girl Called Tills to him and his Heirs forever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Thomas Newsum one Shilling

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Moses Newsum one Shilling

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Sampson Newsum one Shilling

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Solomon Newsum one Shilling

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Nathan Newsum one Shilling

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Amos Newsum one Shilling

Item I Give and bequeath to my Two Daughters Ann Hold & Sarah Barham all my wearing Apparel to be Equally Divided between them

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Barham my side Saddle

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son David Newsum all and singular the Goods Chattels and all the Rest of my Moveable Estate and a Negro Wench Called Frank to him and his Heirs forever I Leave my Son David Newsum my whole & Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament In Witnes hereof I have set
