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Item I Give & Bequeath to my son Richard Taylor my plantation whereon William Drewry is now Overseer with all the Lands Thold there as^t after my son Henry has his Land of, also the seven following Negro's, Young Sam, Sew, Joe, Isaac, David, Ben Jany's Child, & Gate and fifty pounds Current Money to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item I Give to my son William Taylor twenty five pounds

Item I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Cary twenty five pounds

Item I Give to my Daughter Mary Taylor one Negro Girl known by the Name of Annakey & three hundred pounds Current Money to her and her heirs for ever

Item My Will and desire is that if either of my Sons Henry, Kinchen, Etheldred, John, James, or Richard should die under age or without Issue that all the Lands and Slaves heretofore given to them and all the other Estate hereafter given to such Child or Children dying as foresaid be Equally divided among such of my s^d Sons as shall survive of their Heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath all the Remainder of my Estate of What Nature or Kind so ever or wheresoever found to be equally divided between my four sons Etheldred, John, James, & Richard Taylor & their Heirs

And Lastly, I hereby appoint my Wife my son William Taylor & my son in law Miles Cary Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereby Revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand this 10th Day of June 1755
