apparel a pot one ew and the Tools on the Plantation
- Item** I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah my Negro
fellow Guy I give thes^d Negro to her & her Heirs
likewise eight head of Cattle eight Head of Hogs
one bed & furniture one large Bason two dishes one
small Bason one Chest one large Pot one Frying Pan
one Ew
- Item** I give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Eight Head
of Cattle eight Head of Hogs one Bed one Blanket
a New Blanket to be bought one sheet and ten Pounds
to be raised out of my Estate one large Bason one dish
one spice Morter & Pestle one Pop Iron one little
Bason one small dish one New Porringer one tub
one Pair one Pot one Ew a Book one Hair calld Fanny

calld Damsel & one young Sow
- Item** I give and bequeath to Mary Steward one Horse Coult
