of my Body knowing that it is appointed for all me Once to Die
do make and Ordain this to be my Last Will and Testament in
manner and form following first I Give and Bequeath my Soul
to God almighty that first Gave it me in full hopes and
assurances of a Resurrection and Redemption through the
merits of me Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and as for my Body
I leave it to be Buried in a Christian like manner at the
Discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as for what
Worldly Estate it hath pleased the Lord to bestow on me I Give
in the Manner and form following

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Nicholas Cobb and his Heirs for
ever one Parcel of Land whereon he Now Lives Containing by Estimation
seventy two Acres be the same more or Less and Boundeth as followeth
and on the South side of the Gum branch and down the Cedar Swamp to
Thomas Shapers Line for Compliment

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son Henry Cobb and his Heirs for ever
a parcel of Land whereon he Now lives Containing by Estimation
seventy two Acres be the same more or Less Boundeth as followeth
Joining on the Cedar Swamp following the line to a Pond for Compliment

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my grandson William Cobb and his Heirs
for ever a parcel of Land whereon his Father William Cobb lived Containing
by Estimation seventy two Acres be the same more or Less and Boundeth
as followeth Lying on the Cedar Swamp and Joining to the Land
I've given to his Uncle Henry Cobb's Likewise Joining the Gum
branch for Compliment
