Joining on the Cedar Swamp following the line to a pond for Compliment
Item I give and Bequeath unto my grandson William Cobb and his Heirs
forever a parcel of Land whereon his Father William Cobb lived Containing
by Estimation seventy two acres be the same more or less and Boundeth
as followeth lying on the Cedar Swamp and Joining to the Land
Ive given to his Uncle Henry Cobb Likewise Joining the Gum
branch for Compliment --
