Item I give unto my Daughter Faith Harris seven Shillings
current Money
Item I give unto my Son Joseph Smith one grey Mare
and my Desire is that what the s^d Mare is appraised
to for my Son Flood Smith to have the half of it paid by
my Son Joseph Smith
Item I give to my Son Absalom Smith one pair of
Pistols & Holsters and one Chest marked Thus R: H: to him
and his Heirs for ever
Item I give unto my Daughter Joane Smith Sixteen Shillings
and eightpence current Money
Item I give unto my Son Lawrence Smith one Feather Bed
and Furniture to him and his Heirs
Item I give unto my Daughter Hannah Smith Two
Feather Beds and Furniture that does belong to them
Item I give unto my Daughter Sarah Smith two
Feather Beds that does belong to them
Item I give unto my two Daughters Hannah Smith
and Sarah Smith all the rest of my Estate after all
just Debts and Funeral Expenses is paid that
