Plates and a Piggins and a butter pot and a Jugg half full of Honey one Ox & two Peacocks a looking glass a frying pan and all my Corn and Fodder and another bed and Furniture and two pair of Cards one Wheel and all the Cotton and all the rest of my Household stuffs

Item I give and bequeath unto John Spence one young Mare one Sow and Pigg

Item I give and bequeath unto Lucy Powell one bed and bolster

Item I give and bequeath unto John McLenore five Shillings

Item It is my Desire that Mary Bras may live on my Plantation here Lifetime

Item It is my Order that five Head of Cattle and the Remainder of my Hogs may be sold to pay my Debts

And I hereby make and appoint my trusty Friend Simon Turner Senior my full and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and Disannulling and making void all former wills and Testaments and requests by me made and Declaring this only to be my last Will & Testament In Witness hereto I have ^{set} my Hand and affixed my Seal the Day & Year first above written &c
