 ral Death also all the stock Belonging to the Plantation
 where I now live And I do hereby Nominate & appoint my
 wife Sarah Gilliam my whole & sole Executor of this Desiring
 her to see this my last Will & Testament Truly performed
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this
 28th Day of April 1758 -
